



Installation is at the purchaser's expense and will vary according to the work and the site.

Commissions

We can arrange commissions, editions and source other works by the artists on show.

Entry

Entry is by koha. We have been asked for guidance – most people contribute \$10-\$15 per adult.

Guided tours

Guided tours are now available, at \$25 per adult at advertised times on open days, or groups by prior arrangement. People who have been on a tour may also explore freely afterwards.

Health and safety
